Visions & Values

- The school's vision is to provide positive learning experiences, which allow students to achieve their optimum level of academic, social, emotional and physical independence.
- As stated in our Positive Behaviour Support Program our school values are *Respect, Safety and Try Your Best*. These values are taught explicitly during our Positive Behaviour Support weekly lesson. Students are rewarded when they display the correct behaviour. The most common reward is verbal praise. Staff are to give 6 positives to 1 corrective. The other rewards are class based reward systems, yard award, bus award and student of the week award and Principal's award which are all presented at our weekly assembly.
- The school encourages parental participation through School Council fundraising sub-committee and volunteering at different events throughout the year.
- The Victorian Curriculum A-D provides students with goals that are stimulating, challenging and targeted at the needs of the individual student.
- Ensuring students attend school every day is a shared responsibility of all parents/carers, students and the school.
- The school enacts its philosophy through: student rewards, displaying the vision in the staff room, facebook and school website, Student Engagement Policy, Strategic Plan and through teaching Positive Behaviour Support on a weekly basis.
